

Admission of Students Age Twenty-One and Older – 3110.2

Students aged twenty-one or older may enroll in schools in the district under the following conditions:

- A. There is available space in the school and program which the student will attend;
- B. Tuition is prepaid;
- C. The student provides his/her own transportation;
- D. The student resides in the State of Washington; and
- E. In the judgment of the superintendent/designee no adult education program is available at reasonable costs and the district's program is appropriate to the needs of the student.
