

Vision and Hearing Screening

Vision and auditory screenings are conducted under the supervision of district nurses and district speech and language pathologists. Records of screening results and referrals made are kept in the students' cumulative files.

- A. Vision acuity screening shall be administered annually to each child in kindergarten, first, second, third, fourth, fifth, and seventh grades. In addition, all students referred by parents, teachers, nurses, or other school personnel will be screened.

When a child has failed two vision screenings, the parent or guardian will be notified of the results and referred for further evaluation (see 3411 F1 and 3411 F2).

- B. Auditory acuity screening shall be administered annually in kindergarten, first, second, third, fourth, fifth, and seventh grades. In addition, all students referred by parents, teachers, nurses or other school personnel will be screened.

When a child has failed two auditory acuity screenings, the parent or guardian will be notified of the screening results and referred for further evaluation (see 3411 F3, 3411 F4, 3411 F5, and 3411 F6)
