

MEDICATION AT SCHOOL

If a student must receive oral medication during the school day-the written authorization and instructions must be provided by the parent and health care provider.

The superintendent shall establish procedures for:

- A. Training staff members in the administration of oral medication.
- B. Designating staff members who may administer oral medications to students.
- C. Receiving parental requests for the administration of oral medications.
- D. Receiving a health care provider's request and instructions regarding a student who will be taking oral medication.
- E. Storing medication that can be administered in accordance with instructions from the parent and health care provider.
- F. Maintaining records pertaining to the administration of oral medications.
- G. Instructing staff on appropriate procedures for dealing with students who bring oral medications to school on their person for self-administering.
- H. Allowing students to carry and self-administer medication at school.
