

Senior Citizen Recognition

The board recognizes and appreciates the contributions senior citizens have made to their community and schools throughout their lifetime. In recognition of these past contributions, the district may

- A. Provide opportunities for citizens aged sixty and above to purchase lunches in school cafeterias at the price charged to employees of the district.
- B. Waive admission fee for non-students of the age of sixty-five or over, who by reason of their low income, would have difficulty in paying the admission fee to a school-sponsored program or athletic event.

The superintendent shall develop procedures for providing these opportunities to eligible citizens.
