

Certification

The district shall require that certificated staff hold a Washington state certificate valid for the role and responsibilities for which they are employed. Failure to meet this requirement shall be just cause for termination of employment. No salary warrants may be issued to a staff member until the district has registered a valid certificate(s) for the assigned role(s).
