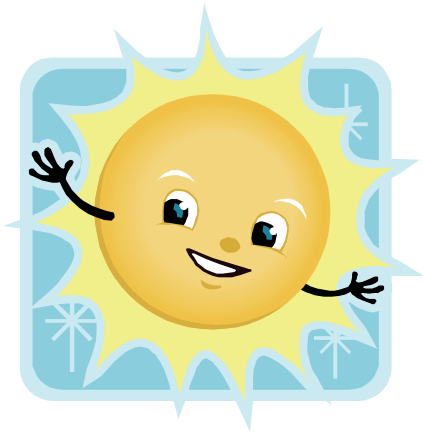


Summer School

The elementary summer school program is for current 1st through 5th grade students who would like to get a jump-start on next year's learning. The program provides for both continuing and remedial assistance over the summer. Summer school classroom teachers use high-leverage instructional practices including *GLAD to improve students' language arts skills, technical (non-fiction) reading and writing, and math skills. Classrooms are limited to 22 students. Each classroom will have a highly qualified teacher and teaching assistant. All students will participate in ongoing formative assessment to measure progress toward learning goals.

This year's summer school participants will enjoy the added benefit of master teachers providing *GLAD units and demonstrations for one week in the classroom.

Summer school is an excellent opportunity to sharpen skills and get a running start for the next school year. Students on Free and Reduced Lunch may be eligible for partial scholarships, if funds are available. Scholarship request forms are available on the district web page. Space is limited, so get your registration in early. Don't miss this opportunity!
