The Issaquah School District is excited to announce an opportunity for incoming Issaquah School District kindergarten students. This free program, funded by the Issaquah School District, is designed to help students get ready to start kindergarten. The program will run for four weeks (July 6 – July 30) from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 and will focus on:

- Developing reading readiness skills and background knowledge/schema
- Developing vocabulary and immersing students in the language of school
- Helping students learn “how to do school”
- Creating school-to-home connections and developing partnerships with parents

The program will also provide:

- Transportation to the host school
- Lessons that encourage a love for reading
- Fun activities aimed at helping students know all about the structure and routines of school
- Daily Snack
- Books to take home
- Parent Training Opportunity
