Online Learning Norms (**Families**)

We know that partnering with families will be a critical factor in the success of remote learning. These norms have been developed to build some common expectations and guidance for how families can best support their child, and to make remote learning a safe and meaningful experience for all involved.

Pursue Excellence

- Encourage your student to attend every class and participate to their fullest
- Help your student to understand their schedule and develop a daily/weekly routine
- If your student needs help or has a question about a class, encourage them to reach out to their teacher first

Act with Integrity

- Students are expected to do their own work
- To promote an inclusive class culture and a greater sense of student privacy, do not interrupt or engage in live instruction when it is taking place
- Help provide your student with a quiet setting so that they can focus and engage

Take Care of Each Other

- Encourage your student to take breaks, and to integrate physical activity into the day as much as possible
- Take care of yourself, and ask for help if you need it (you are not in this alone)
- Ask your student how they are doing, and don't hesitate to reach out to the teacher or the school for assistance if your student is struggling
