

## Skyline High School 2020 AP Exam Announcement

For students interested in taking the 2020 Advanced Placement Exams, please follow these instructions. Please contact Shawnette Brandt, [brandts@issaquah.wednet.edu](mailto:brandts@issaquah.wednet.edu) in the counseling department if you have any questions.

1. Registration for the 2020 AP exams are still open. We ask that students who are registering for AP test(s) do so no later than March 11, 2020. Registration takes only a few minutes and can be completed from any computer with internet access. Click on the follow link to register: [2020 AP Exam Registration](#).
2. Registration after October 31, 2019 will incur a \$40.00 late fee per registration.
3. Please note that registration is through **Issaquah High School**.
4. Be sure to list your school as Skyline High School and the CEEB code as 480501
5. Student must answer all the required questions to complete the registration process. Registration is incomplete until students have printed the pdf of the confirmation page that is provided at the end.
6. **Before we can order AP exam(s), all students must "enroll" their AP exam(s) with College Board.** Once you've completed the registration on Issaquah High School's website, you will be provided with information and a link to complete your enrollment with College Board. Join codes are available in the Skyline High School Counseling Center. Please complete this final step right after registering to guarantee your AP exam(s) will be ordered.
7. We know that parents may desire to register their student for an AP exam. However, we strongly recommend that parent(s) and student are both present while registering to ensure that the correct exams are ordered.
8. Skyline High School is excited to offer families the convenience of paying exams fees online at the time of registration. Please be sure to have a **credit or debit card available before beginning registration**. Paying online is a great way to make sure that payment has been made while avoiding delays that can occur by mail.
9. This year, each AP exam cost \$98.00

11. All exam(s) **will take place at Issaquah High School**.
12. The AP Exam schedule is listed below. **Please note – if you are scheduled to take IB exam(s) at Skyline it may conflict with the AP schedule.** Please do not schedule an AP exam when you are scheduled to take an IB exam. **The exam(s) cannot be moved.**
13. Students must provide their own transportation to Issaquah High School. Parking is limited so please arrive early or by carpool.
14. Students should coordinate with their Skyline High School teacher to make-up missed assignments due to testing.
