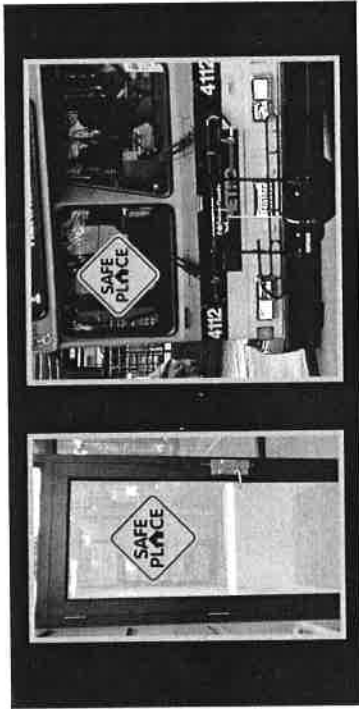

How to access Safe Place

Teens ages 12-17 in King County who need a safe place to stay:

Call 1 (800) 422-TEEN 24/7

OR

Go to any designated Safe Place location
(look for the yellow diamond logo)



A Safe Place coordinator will arrive within 45 minutes to provide assistance

OVERWHELMED? FRUSTRATED?

Project SAFE is a free phone-based clinical consultation program for parents and caregivers of youth ages 12-17 who are struggling with their teen's behavior.

During the call, a counselor will **listen**, provide **tools for coping** with your teen, and help you develop an **action plan** to take care of yourself and improve the situation for you and your teen.

WHO CAN CALL?

Parents and caregivers of youth ages 12-17 in King County.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

- 1.** Struggling with your teen?
- 2.** Call 1 (888) 99-VOICE and ask for a Project SAFE appointment.
- 3.** You'll schedule a free 90-minute clinical phone consultation.
- 4.** SAFE will also provide a free 30-minute follow up call.
