

Spartan Lunch Zones

Per the Memorandum of Understanding (this is the agreement between the teacher's union and the district) "students will be assigned zones at lunch." To accomplish this, we will be assigning seats for lunch. You will have the opportunity to self-select your seat and location on campus the first day that attend. You only must do this once and then sit in the seat for the rest of the year.

Seats are in different areas, both inside and outside the building:

- Olympic Gym (OG)
- Upper Commons (UC)
- Lower Commons (LC)
- Spartan Stadium (SS)
- Spartan Stadium Courtyard (SSC)

Within each area, the seats are numbered and color coded to indicate the lunch "zones" and seat number. Each zone will not exceed 30 students. This will remain your seat for the remainder of the school year.

What do I do when I arrive at lunch?

- Maintain appropriate social distance as you approach the lunch area. Remember: 6 feet!
- Scan the QR code taped to the seat/desk. Then, enter the information requested on the form.
- Take your seat and then enjoy your lunch!

What if I don't have a phone or can't scan the QR code?

- Adults will be supervising the lunch area and will have iPads available for students to use for this purpose.

How can I choose my seat?

- Students should talk to friends before selecting a seat and ensure they have selected seats they wish to remain for the duration of the year.
- Students are expected to remain/return to the same seat daily.

What if I decide to leave campus for lunch. Can I do that?

- You bet! Students may choose to leave campus if they are a junior or senior.
- Parents of juniors and seniors should have completed the off-campus form here- [Lunch Release 2020-2021](#).
 - Once completed, please scan the QR code form if you are leaving campus.
 - If you elect to return on a different day to eat lunch on campus, please follow the QR instructions indicated on the seats of the **Spartan Stadium**.
- Reminder- we should not be in our cars during school hours unless we are leaving campus.
